Paediatric Medication Resources

The following are some helpful paediatric medication resources. Take the time to check what resources are approved for use within your emergency department. Clinicians working in Townsville, Cairns and Gold Coast Hospital and Health Services should follow their local paediatric empirical antimicrobial therapy guidelines. Clinicians elsewhere in Queensland should follow the Children's Health Queensland's (CHQ's) paediatric antimicrobial prescribing guidelines until the results of microbiological investigations are available. 
What to use it for?

Use the <u>Australian Medicines Handbook (AMH) Children's Dosing</u>
<u>Companion</u> to check all your oral, enteral, rectal and intravenous paediatric medication dosages are correct.



What to use it for?

Use <u>The Royal Children's Hospital Melbourne Paediatric Injectable</u>
<u>Guideline</u> for guidance on paediatric intravenous, intramuscular and subcutaneous medication preparation, administration and compatibility.



What to use it for?

Use The <u>Children's Resuscitation Emergency Drug Dosage (CREDD)</u> book for paediatric resuscitation and emergency drug guidance. This is a weight-based book that provides direction on the correct dosage, preparation, administration and compatibility of resuscitation drugs.
